

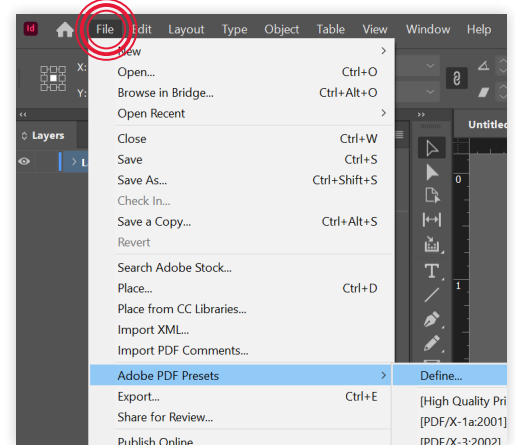
Installing Presets & Libraries

Download the “PrintReadyPDF.joboptions” export preset & the “CC Color Library.cclibs” files from goNextPage.com.

Importing the “PrintReadyPDF” Preset

1. InDesign menu bar: **File > Adobe PDF Presets > Define.**
2. In pop up menu select: **Load > PrintReadyPDF.joboptions.**

Voilà! Now, you should have our PDF export preset installed for NextPage print-ready PDFs!

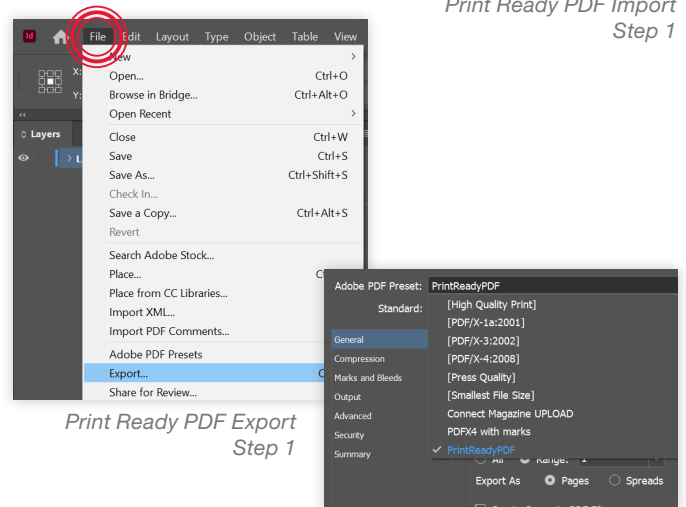


Print Ready PDF Import Step 1

Exporting a “Print Ready” PDF

1. InDesign menu bar: **File > Export.**
2. In the Export menu, select your save location & file name, then select “Save.”
3. In the pop-up menu, under the Adobe PDF Preset drop-down list, select “PrintReadyPDF.”
4. Select “Export.”

Voilà! Now, when this option is chosen, your PDF exports are NextPage print-ready!



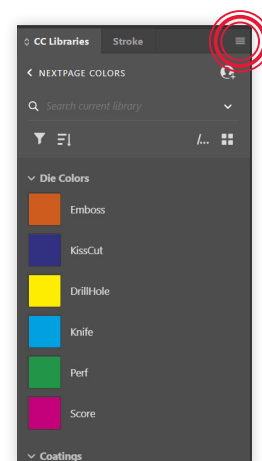
Print Ready PDF Export Step 1

Importing the NextPage Color Library

1. InDesign menu bar: **Window > CC Libraries.**
2. In CC Libraries pane, select “more options” from pop-out menu (upper, right corner of panel). Then, select “Import Library.”
3. In the pop-up menu, select “Select Library.” Then, choose “Nextpage_Colors.cclibs” & select “Open.”
4. Select “Import.”

Voilà! The NextPage Color library will now be visible in the CC Libraries pane. Each spot color has a description added to it for your convenience.
